

- 4. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in NEET (UG) 2023, the inter-se-merit of such candidates has been determined as per Chapter Chapter 15 {15.2} of Information Bulletin of NEET (UG) -2023 to generate NEET All India Rank.
- 5. NTA has declared only NEET All India Rank and All India Rank for Counselling. Candidates may apply to the designated Counselling Authorities as per their eligibility. NTA has no role to play in this.
- 6. Details of the various Counselling Authorities are given in Appendix-II of Information Bulletin. The same may also be confirmed from respective websites. NTA is notresponsible for change of any of the addresses though care has been taken to put correct addresses.
- 7. Counselling Authorities will invite applications from the successful candidates and prepare their own merit list as per their rules based on All India Rank.
- 8. In NEET (UG) 2023 result, category of the candidates is as per details submitted by them in online form. In case, if the category of candidate falls under any other category in the State Category List, candidates may apply to designated Counselling Authorities with their category as per State Category List, and designated Counselling Authorities will verify the same. The same is the case with domicile. Domicile will be governed by respective admitting authority rules. NTA will not change any details of the candidates after declaration of result.
- 9. All candidates are advised to remain in touch with the websites of Counselling Authorities for updates.
